- Public Facilities/Utilities – help identify problem areas and opportunities (roads, drinking water, wastewater, flooding, garbage/recycling, parks, schools, libraries, medical facilities, communications, energy)
- Growth Management – help identify areas that you believe should or should not be available for development
- Agricultural and Economic Opportunities – help identify existing or potential business establishments, existing farms, “assets” that support agriculture (things like farmers markets, incubator kitchens, irrigation systems, good agricultural land)
