Treat Kapoho Beach Lots and Vacationland Wastewater

Designate Volcano Village as part of an International Biosphere Reserve

Conduct an Environmental Study for a Puna Makai Alternative Roadway (PMAR)[4.3.3]

- Urge Governor to release funds for the study
- Clarify scope of the project
- Remain true to the context of PMAR in the PCDP

Prepare Draft Community long Range Plans for Pahoā, Orchidland, Maku'u, and Volcano Village

- Update and bring forward a previously done plan for Pahoā
- Revise and re-format the Volcano Long Range Plan
- Include architectural review

Designate Connecting Roadways in Puna Subdivisions

- Identify emergency routes
- Distinguish connecting roads from PMAR

Secure Wireless Internet Service for all of Puna

- Collaborate with Hawaiian Telcom
- Seek County and/or State support
- Emphasize this as an extension of emergency services to underserved communities

Acquire and Develop Neighborhood and Coastal Parks

- Develop existing sites (parks?)
- Identify and support culturally appropriate parks
- Expand existing parks to include athletic fields
- Include Cape Kumukahi, Waiopai Tidal Ponds

Designate Red Road as a National Scenic Byway [4.5.3 (f)]

Develop an Agriculture Tourism Policy [3.2.3 (h)]

- Emphasize farmers' markets

Secure Land and Build Infrastructure for Community Farmers' Markets [3.2.3 (f)]

Upgrade Wastewater Disposal Practices in Lower Puna

- Emphasize Maku'u Project (DHHL)
