

**PLANPACIFIC WORKING PAPER #2 – MĀLAMA I KA `AINA
Presentation to the Puna CDP Steering Committee on July 19, 2007**

1. Need to look into the Highway & Trails Act of 1892 to help identify legitimate public rights-of-way.
2. A native vegetation element should be included in the purview of a historic/cultural preservation commission.
3. Plan to preserve the water table in undeveloped areas of Puna from further contamination by individual waste water systems.
4. DOH and DHHL have failed to listen to the people regarding waste water disposal in Puna.
5. The use of composting toilets with gray water disposal is another alternative to cesspools and septic tanks that should be considered.
6. Some of the recommendations of the Agricultural Working Group were not addressed in the presentation; other elements (e.g., bio-fuels and farm tours) did not come from the Agricultural Working Group recommendations.
